

NBC Smoking Policy

It is the policy of NBC Sports Club to protect the health and sporting performance of all its members by adopting a 'Smoke-Free Greens' Policy for all bowling events conducted at NBC Sports Club

NBC Sports Club acknowledges and endorses the Tobacco Amendment Bill 2012 which amends the Smoke Free Environment Act 2000 and NBC Sports Club acknowledge the damage that cigarette tobacco smoke can cause, and the highly addictive nature of the habit.

NBC Sports Club also acknowledges that council across the state have imposed smoking bans on council owned property while children are playing sport or enjoying recreational activity, and in some cases banned smoking outright. It is also acknowledged that other state governments have banned smoking on greens and surrounds.

NBC Sports Club is reticent to take any action or enforce policies that may have a damaging effect on, or which fall within the jurisdiction of NBC Sports Club.

NBC Sports Club acknowledge the need to create a safe environment for our Bowling Members, volunteers and officials.

The controlling Body will have the power to worn any bowler that is caught smoking outside of the designated area, if the request is not followed the supervisor on duty will be informed and you will be removed from the premises.
