Pennant Teams off to a great start

After 8 rounds of the grade 2-7 Zone 10 Pennant and Grade 1 State Metropolitan Competition NBC Sports Club is achieving some good result which could see several teams qualify for the Zone 10 Pennant Finals

Grade One

NBC Sports Club currently sits in 6th position on the ladder on 44.5 points. The boys will need to win at least 2 out of the 3 remaining games against Grandviews, Mount Lewis & Belrose. Both the marquee players Nathan Wilson & Kurt Brown have fitted into the club very well and are starting to meet all the members of the club.

Grade Two

Currently sitting in 4th position on the ladder on 32 points and take on third place Carlingford this week. It has been a tough battle this year, but the players have committed well, and 3 wins could see them sneak into the top 2.

Grade Three

Currently sitting in second spot but leading section 2 on 52.5. Last week the boys beat the "Red Hot Favourites" Toongabbie 9-1. One more win will secure a spot in the finals but I'm sure the side won't the top spot. This week they travel to Castle Hill.

Grade Five

Currently sitting in 2nd spot in section 2 on 49 points after an awesome display last week against North Ryde RSL. The team has a couple of injuries this week and could be without a couple of key players as they take on the 1st place Putney Tennyson.

Grade Six

Currently in 1st position in section 3 on 55.5 points 25.5 points clear of 2nd position Wenty Leagues. The boys have not lost a game this year and will look to cement a spot in the finals with a win this week.

Seven One

Currently in 3rd position in Section 1 on 36 points 4 points behind Toongabbie. With three rounds remaining the boys will need a strong finish to the year to make a spot in the finals. A win this week against Wenty Leagues would go a long way to securing a spot

Seven Two

Currently sitting in 1st position in section 2 on 57 points. This grade has been the surprise package of the year and another win will see them play in the pennant finals. A big congratulations to selector Stephen Blackburn who begged the committee to enter a grade another grade 7 team so most players would get a run.

At 6.00pm each Saturday, the Pennants Draw will take place. Each player that nominated to play pennants (including reserves and side managers) have been allocated a number.

Each week \$100 can be won. The numbers will be entered into the random number generator and if the player drawn is present, they will win the money. If the player is not present, the \$100 jackpots to the next round.

Selectors will meet every Sunday afternoon to select the next round. Players that wish to discuss matters with selectors are encouraged to do so in a positive manner. If you wish to attend a selection meeting, it is best to advise the Chairman, Brett Hughes beforehand that you will be attending.

Selected teams will be available by 5pm on the Tuesday afternoon prior to the next round. They will be placed on the notice board and can also be viewed on the club's website, team app and on the Northmead Bowling Club Facebook Page.
